Dear Resident,

This is a follow-up to last week's general update. Changes to our community's restrictions will be cautious, carefully planned, and measured. Public health authorities continue to advise vulnerable populations to shelter in place.

At this time, our current restrictions remain in place. Local county and state orders have not been issued yet that advise businesses and public places of the date for a first phase of relaxed restrictions. When we are informed and have a date for the onset of Phase 1 relaxations, I will communicate it to you. Expect that we will maintain a conservative approach to Phase 1 and all our phases. We're going to keep you and our staff protected. We will continue to deliver meals and provide activity cart visits and doorway activities to keep everyone active and engaged.

We know this is difficult. We want nothing more than to get back to some normalcy, but we must wait for direction from county and state officials before we can begin to ease into the recovery process.

Please remember to be mindful of current protocols. Practice social-distancing measures along with maintaining frequent handwashing and sanitizing.
